

## Meeting 18/7/07

### Proposals/Strategies

Managers keep originals, people get photocopies to take home, originals handed out at rehearsals.

Scores for this semester- Lachlan has not been able to track any of the pieces down in Australia. Tried Canberra Choral Society Choir School, ANU School of Music, OUP, National Music Library, CPDL- online versions. None had it. It was suggested that Lachlan try other online sites, such as everynote.com. Alternatively we will have to buy them (several thousand) or hire from overseas, or get Jonathon to pick something new. Lachlan/Jesse to talk to Jonathon about it.

- **SCUNA Budget** - \$19,000 but haven't paid NCO, \$3,000. Also will be getting a retrospective grant. Try for \$1,500.
- **SCUNA Webpage** – Maybe have a section of 'friends of SCUNA' on the webpage, so that we email people before concerts. Send names of new committee members. Update orchestra and choir rehearsal venue and time.
- **Change signatories to the bank account.** Take AGM Minutes and photo id, to St George bank in the city.
- **Bush Week.** Wednesday Clubs and Societies Day, Adrian has the banner. Take table and chairs etc. 10-4pm. Volunteers to man the stall. See if we can get a group for a performance between 1-2pm. Play old SCUNA CD's. Put posters up around uni etc.
- **SCUNA Camp** – 22 and 23<sup>rd</sup> September at Warrambui. Paid deposit. Tone down drinking. Price, transport- buses?, food. Organised next meeting.
- **Report from Intervarsity Festival** – 7 SCUNA people attended. Quite good, all choirs experiencing same problems/issues, next meeting. We are hosting Intervarsity 2010. Need to organise a steering committee. Need at least 6 people – Adrian suggested we think about having it in Summer – 10-11 days instead of 2 and half weeks. Aim for a big group to go to Sydney next year. Adrian proposes a

grant for first time IV attendees of about \$50. Healthy for the choir. Veronica willing to give a plug every week about IV to try and encourage people to go. Will mean people know what to do for 2010. Need to get films of previous IV's etc to encourage people to go.

- SCUNA lacking socially compared to other choirs. Propose to social officer. Eg out for drinks, coffee, BBQ, house party, trivia night, karaoke.
- **AICSA** - Ada to pay AICSA fees. AICSA to be incorporated into next years Intersarsity. AICSA mailing list needs to be changed.
- **19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> October Concert** – 19<sup>th</sup> in Goulburn at St Saviours Cathedral. Get Matthew Stuckings more involved, maybe conduct a piece at the concert. Hire buses. 20<sup>th</sup> October booked in for St Christopher's.
- **May 18<sup>th</sup> Next year**- Great Hall of Parliament House.
- March next year – NCO and choir.
- **Orchestra** small concert in October at University House. 18<sup>th</sup> August, SCUNA orchestra to play at International Ball at National Museum.

#### **General Business.**

- **Songbooks**- We need more songbooks to be printed. - Jesse to organise.
- **Archiving** needs to be done. Old executive to organise.
- **CD's** - Beethoven and Harvard CD's. – we need new contact with Annabelle Wheeler at Art Sound – Jesse to do. Sandy to do CD's
