5. October Concerts:

- **Venue confirmation-** St Christopher's is confirmed, St Saviours is nearly confirmed.
- Pieces and issues with orchestra-
- When we couldn't find the Bruckner Mass in D minor Jonathon was concerned about what to do. Will we have enough time to learn it? Need to decide tonight. For the Bruckner a small scale Romantic orchestra is required.
- Can't perform Bruckner Mass in E minor was already performed in 2002. Also, orchestration could prove difficult with current orchestra.
- If we don't perform the Bruckner we need to have other options for the orchestra.
 Jesse has discussed some of these with Jonathon 1st option to do Handel and Purcell

and then do a third piece that is for the woodwind, 2^{nd} option was to get Jonathon to choose new pieces involving the full orchestra, 3^{rd} option was to reorchestrate the Purcell and Handel for the full orchestra, 4^{th} option was to buy the Bruckner and perform it – costs \$800-\$1000.

- Jonathon was assuming that because we were having problems building up the orchestra that we should have a completely separate concert for the orchestra and just get a string ensemble in for the choir pieces. Perhaps a blended group of our best string players and some semi-professional string players for the choir concert.
- We also have the option of doing a wind only piece at the choir concert.
- Seperate orchestra concert (Date to be confirmed perhaps on Sunday afternoon 21st October.) Perhaps Matt Stuckings could conduct orchestra concert and Jonathon could conduct choir?
- **Final Decision:** Choir to perform Bach, Handel, and Purcell in Goulburn on 19th, and Canberra 20th October accompanied by a string ensemble made up of some of our best players and some other semi-professionals brought in to play. At these concerts we may also have a performance by a woodwind ensemble from the orchestra. This concert to be conducted by Jonathon (?)

 The Orchestra will be performing in a separate concert on an unconfirmed date (possibly Sunday 21st October) and will be conducted by Matt Stuckings (?)
