

SCUNA Committee Meeting 27th June 2008

Present: Nathanael Cox, Petra Lindsay, Alexander O'Sullivan, Sandie Walters.

The meeting opened at 5:45pm

1. Bush Week

- It was decided that SCUNA would not set up a stall on Market Day, given previous poor recruitment at this event.
- Instead a poster run will be organized, detailing what SCUNA is and when rehearsal times are.

2. Fauré Requiem Scores

- Sandie has arranged with the library network the access of ~100 scores. There is also an order going out with Better Music for ~30 scores ordered by members.
- It was noted that there are many editions of the Requiem, and that Petra must liaise with Jonathan in order to achieve consistency.

3. Songbooks

- It was decided that another reprint of songbooks (c.150-200) was required.
- The copyright status of the Tim Finn song, and "Rubber Ducky" was not resolved.
- It was agreed that any changes to the structure and content of the songbook would be made after the reprint.
- Nathanael agreed to contact the Union about the possibility of a print quota for SCUNA.

4. Academic Dinner

- Petra proposed an Academic Dinner modeled on those of other AICSA members. A venue is yet to be formally decided upon.
- Songbooks and a running sheet will be needed for speeches.

5. Social Events

- It was noted that SCUNA members seemed resistant to organized social activity.
- A number of ideas were discussed, including dinner at the Asian Kitchen before rehearsal in winter, or at Sizzle Bento when the weather becomes more clement. The possibility of a movie night with the ANU Film Group was also mentioned.
- The importance of "selling" the social events was established.

6. Rehearsals

- It was suggested that the first part of rehearsal (c.7-7:30pm) be used for learning songbook songs. This part of the rehearsal would not need to be taken by Alan and/or Jonathan.
- The idea of projecting sheet music to save on copying was discussed and agreed on as a good idea.
- Alexander and Petra both stated willingness to lead songbook learning. It was also decided that the Conducting and Accompaniment students would be offered experience in the SCUNA choir in the event of the usual musical staff being absent. Alex agreed to contact the appropriate lecturers (Susanne Powell and Max McBride respectively) in the new semester.

7. Handover Issues

- Nathanael informed the committee that the executive office bearers would need to sort out the handover personally for the SCUNA bank account.

The next meeting will take place at **5:30pm on Wednesday 23rd July 2008**. The venue is the **Sizzle Bento** on Campus.
