- 1) Apologies: Barbara Carney sent her apologies and resignation as Assistant Concert Manager. Present: Vicki Moss, Michael Mills, John Agnew, Andrew Koll, Eva Schroeder, Charis Messalina, Gerrie Titulaer, Richy Han and Liese Baker.
- 2) **Business arising from the minutes: Michael** will write to ANU student members about their membership, offering a refund of \$15 to those who paid for the year and notifying those who paid for a semester, that their membership is now current for the full year.
- 3) **Treasurer's Report:** Discussion of the limited budget which will be available for the 2nd semester concert.
- 4) **Jubilate Deo progress:** Eva reported on ticket sales (60) and publicity. Charis reported that all the orchestra positions have now been filled and went through the final week of preparation.
